Property Owned by Parties

2. Each party must attach an itemization of property that each party wants to hold free and clear of any interest that other party may acquire by virtue of contemplated marriage. (Please consider whether you want to hold as separate property: future earnings from personal services, income from separate property, increase in value of separate property.)
